Reference is made to your application for an exception to Rule 502 I (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations for your Humble-Continental Navajo Tribe of Indians B-1 Well, located in Section 29, Township 32 North, Range 20 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is understood that an exception to Rule 502 I (a) is necessitated by the unusual flow characteristics of the well in question as set forth in your application.

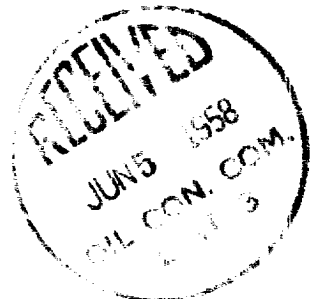
By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 502 I (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 502 I (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations and authorized to produce the above-described well at a daily rate not to exceed 150 barrels of oil; provided however, that nothing contained herein shall be construed as authorizing the production of said well in excess of the monthly tolerance set forth in Rule 502 II of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
