
Our office has been notified by letter dated February 14, 2001, from the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) addressing inspections performed on Navajo Oil and Gas Lease 14-20-603-5012 by Ms. Linda Taylor, Reality Specialist for the BIA, Shiprock, New Mexico. Based on Ms. Taylor's inspections, nineteen Plugged and Abandoned wells are recommended for final surface abandonment. They are:
