## 13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

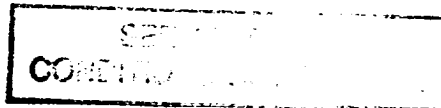
This is in response to your letter of 11-3-92.

We propose to extend the TA status of this well for ~~five~~ <sup>one</sup> years.

Meridian Oil has completed three major workover recompletions and drilled two new Paradox wells in the field in the last twelve months.

However, four of these wells are still not on pipeline yet, with the fifth being first delivered only last month.

We plan to observe the on-line producing characteristics of these five wells for several years before proceeding with workover plans on the Ute #11, in order to insure prudent development.
