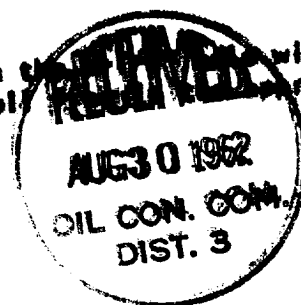

DETAILS OF WORK

Anticipated TD: 1785 in Sanostee
Plan to drill 9" surface hole and set 1 joint, approximately 30' 7" surface casing and cement with 8 sacks regular cement.
Plan to core the Gallup (Tosito) sandstone if present.
Plan to run approximately 1780' of 4-1/2" oil string inside the casing with cement to rise 200' above highest perforation and sand-oil.
Estimate amounts of 10,000 gallons and 20,000#.

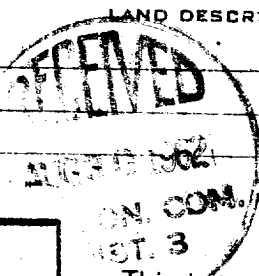

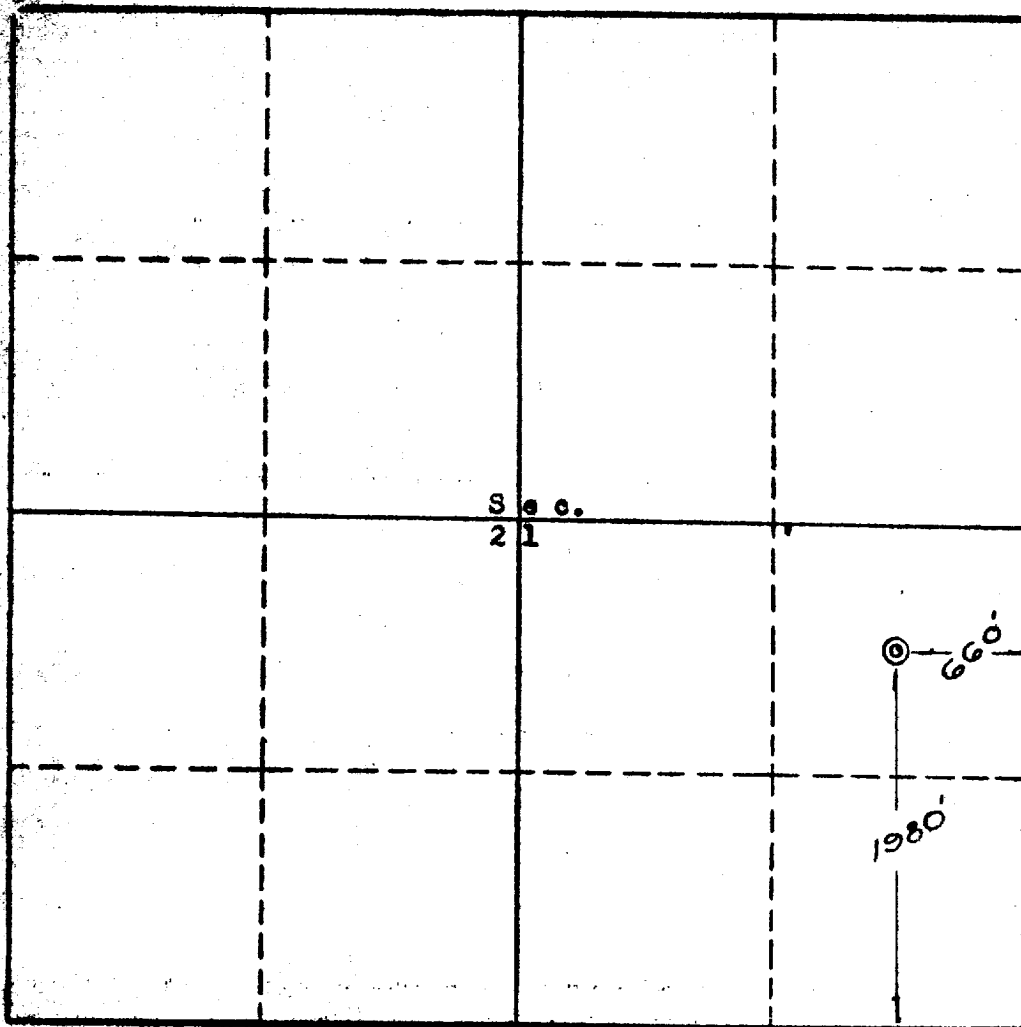
