Rotary Total Depth 4700 ft. 4720' 5 1/2" J-55 Casing was cemented to Total Depth with 250 sacks, July 20, 1951.

Cable tools moved on July 26th. Casing tested with 500# for 30 minutes with no leaks. Plug was drilled and fluid level checked with 500# for two hours with no drop in fluid.
