Reference is made to the following wells located San Juan County, New Mexico:

- 1) No. 1 Davidson A, 990' FNL & 990' FEL sec. 21, T. 28 N., R. 10 W., Lease NMSF-077383.
- 2) No. 1 Moore LS, 990' FNL & 1750' FEL sec. 27, T. 32 N., R. 12 W., Lease NMSF-078147.

Also referenced are your Sundry Notices approved on August 27, 1999, which proposed returning the wells to production by November 1, 1999. If the wells have been returned to production, you are required to submit a subsequent report. If the wells have not been placed on production, you are required to complete the work as approved and submit a subsequent report by January 15, 2000.

Failure to comply within the time above may result in an assessment in accordance with 43 CFR 3163.1.

Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P. O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115. Such requests shall not result in a suspension of the order(s) unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et seq.
