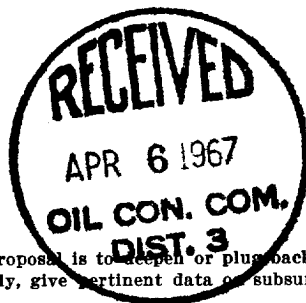

## PROPOSED CASING AND CEMENTING PROGRAM

It is proposed that 7-inch surface pipe be set at 30 feet and cemented. Drill a 6-1/4" hole with air and/or mud to 2250 feet. Run pipe or plug and abandon as indicated by logs and tests.
