A 12-1/4" surface hole was spudded at 4:00 p.m., May 30, 1973. The 8-5/8" casing was set at 322' with 200 sacks Class "A" cement with 2X CaCl2 on June 1, 1973. The cement circulated. Reduced the hole to 7-7/8" at 322'.

The well was drilled to a total depth of 3244'. The 5-1/2" casing was set at 3244' with 450 sacks Class "C" cement with 4X Gal and 2 pounds medium Taf Plug per sack followed by 100 sacks Class "C" Neat on June 7, 1973. The cement did not circulate.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
