
Dear Mr. Woosley:

Reference is made to your letter dated March 11, 1983, wherein you requested authority to complete your Navajo Well No. 17, located 790 feet from the North line and 1826 feet from the West line of Section 28, Township 32 North, Range 17 West, NMPM, San Juan County, as a tubing-less completion in the Many Rocks-Gallup Pool. Your application shows that this well has 4 1/2-inch casing set and cemented at 1690 feet in the Mancos Shale formation and open hole from 1690 feet to 1733 feet in the Lower Gallup Sandstone formation and that this well makes no water nor condensate.

It is our understanding that tubing will be installed at such time as there is a pipeline connection and a market for the gas.

Woosley Oil Company is hereby authorized to complete the subject well in the aforesaid manner.
