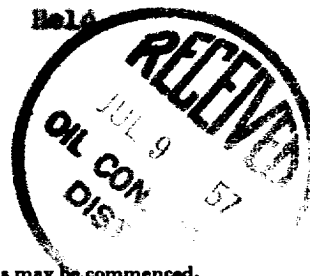

On 6-15-57, Total Depth 4300'.
Ran 105 joints 7-5/8", 26.40#, J-55 casing (4297') set at 4297'.
Two stage cementing tool at 2152'. First stage 50 sacks Regular cement, 50 sacks Pozmix with $\frac{1}{4}$ gal and 1/4# Floccals per sack, followed with 50 sacks Neat Cement. Second stage 75 sacks Regular cement, 75 sacks Pozmix with $\frac{1}{4}$ gal and 1/4# Floccals per sack. Held 1000# 30 minutes.
Top of cement by temperature survey on second stage at 1535'.
