Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Turner-Abraham, Olla-Government Well No. 1-26 to be located 700 feet from the North line and 800 feet from the West line and in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 28, Township 25 North, Range 6 West, Canyon Largo Pictured Cliffs Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

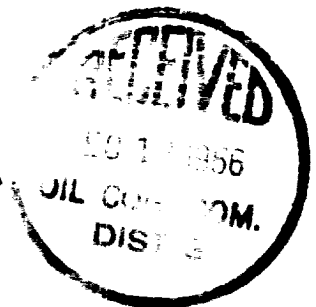
It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NW/4 of said section.

You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.
