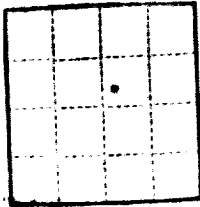

Plan in operations were completed on August 18, 1960, as telephonically arranged. Although permission had been received some time ago to plug this hole, this operation was delayed due to indecision as to whether or not to rework the hole for electric logging.

The plug-in was as follows:

- 100' plug in bottom of hole
- 50' plug 520' to 570'
- 50' plug and 4" surface pipe at surface.
- A total of 16 sacks of cement were used in
