By letter "Decision - Lease Terminated" the office of Bureau of Land Management, Division of Land and Minerals, Program Management and Land office, Santa Fe, New Mexico, Terminated the above referenced lease. Letter was dated July 16, 1968. At that time, by agreement of the Farmington office I made a deal with Mr. Johnny Myers for the plugging of the wells on this lease and the cleaning up of same for the equipment. Mr. Myers has been contacted and he states that the Gartner 1 water well has been plugged in the following manner.

Cement plug was set from 800 to 900' and the hole was filled to surface with mud. Surface plug was set and marker was set. September 5, 1968.

Pit will be filled and fence will be moved. At that time another report will be filed with this office.

The old abandoned capletool rig that is on this land was there long before I had this lease. Judging from the appearance of the rig, I would say that it has been there at least 20 years. I do not own it or have any rights to it. This lease was purchased from Mr. J I Harvey and I am sure he filed any logs.
