

Please accept our apologies for not sending you copies of subsequent report on form C-105 on the subject well. We did submit form C-103 indicating that the well was abandoned and that proper plugging was made. We have enclosed copies of these forms as approved by you. We did not realize that an additional form was required, so we are enclosing C-105's at this time.

At this date, all pits have been leveled and the proper 4' marker has been placed at the well site and the location is available for inspection at any time. The drilling site restoration has also received the approval of Gordon Bond, Albuquerque, who owns surface and mineral rights on the Lease.

Because we drilled volcanics or Rhyolite Tuff and no shows or sands were encountered, we did not run a log on this well. The formation record was reported by geologists and a sample logging truck that we had on the drilling site. Thank you for your interest and reminder and please contact us if any additional information is desired.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK (FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Drilled to 3675', through igneous rock. No shows or water sands encountered. We intend to set 13 3/8 surface casing at 404' and cement to surface. Will set 9 5/8 protection casing at 1217' with cement. We intend to fill the well with heavy mud from TD to 1350'. Spot cement plug from 1350 up into the 9 5/8 casing to 1150'. Will cut off surface pipe, fill with heavy mud and place cement plug with 4' marker pipe in top of cement plug, in accordance with the telephone conversation of July 12, 1960, with Gary Arnold.
