Well # 13 was the last well drilled by the geologist that I had hired to drill and complete all the wells in this field. Shortly after he drilled this well he was removed from this project. The well records evidently went with him and I have no record of this well in my files except notes that were made by Mr. McConnell and filed. It is our intention to have our engineer re-evaluate this hole at the time we install the flood. If this well can fit into the overall flood pattern it will be retained. Should it prove to be of no value to the flood, we will make application to plug and will do so.

According to our file notes there was a show of oil from 328' to 348' 383' to 400'
