## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The hole was plugged in a workmanlike manner, and cement plugs were placed as follows:

at 4000' with 15 sacks cement	1680' with 20 sacks cement
2625' " 15 " "	750' " 20 sacks "
2380' " 15 " "	300' " 12 " "
2200' " 15 " "	

The hole was filled with heavy mud in between each cement plug. The marker was cemented in with 5 sacks cement. 326' of 13-3/8" was lost in hole, all other casing was recovered.
