

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casing, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Request that permission be granted to place the old Reserve Oil Company's No. 4 Navajo on pump and produce from open hole from 810 to 818. This well was reentered January 26, 1954 and cleaned out. It was found that there were 525 feet of oil in the well and approximately 250 feet of water. Bailing tests performed since cleaning out indicate that the well might make 20 to 40 barrels of oil daily. It was found that the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing was at 810 feet or the same amount

as that shown run by former operators.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.


