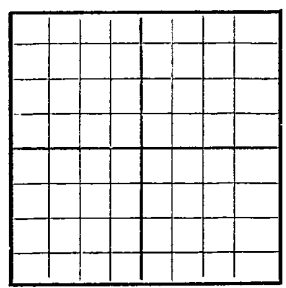

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill the above well to a depth of approximately 7500' to test the Dakota.

Surface casing will be set at approximately 7500', the oil spring will be set at approximately 7500'. Casing will be tested for water shut off both before and after drilling of plugs.
350', 10 3/4" cement circulated.
7' or 5 1/2" cemented w/ 250 sx.

Any zones or formations that may appear productive will be tested as the well progresses.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
