

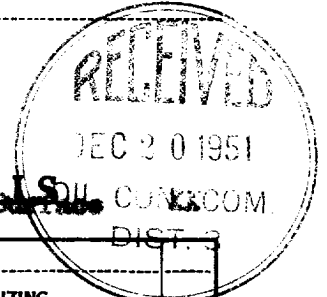

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Drilled 7:30 A.M. on 12/2/51.
2. Ran 5 fts. (104') of 8-5/8" OD, 10 "V" thd., 32#/ft. casing set at 112' KB with 95 sacks of regular cement and circulated to the surface on 12/5/51.
3. Tested casing with 500# pressure held for 30 minutes and showed no drop in pressure.
4. After drilling plug, tested for 30 minutes with 300#. The water level remained stationary.

I understand that this work must be approved by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
