DETAILS OF WORK

Rotary drilled 7-7/8" hole to 1700'. Top of P.C. at 1594'. Set 1598' of 5 1/2" O.D. production pipe and cemented with 75 sacks using spacers, cement shoe and float collar. Bumped last plug with 900# pressure and held for 20 Min. Rotary off, spudder on and after 72 Hrs. drilled cement plug and cleaned hole. Deepened to 1705' with spudder, cleaned out and shot with 340 quarts solidified Nitro.
