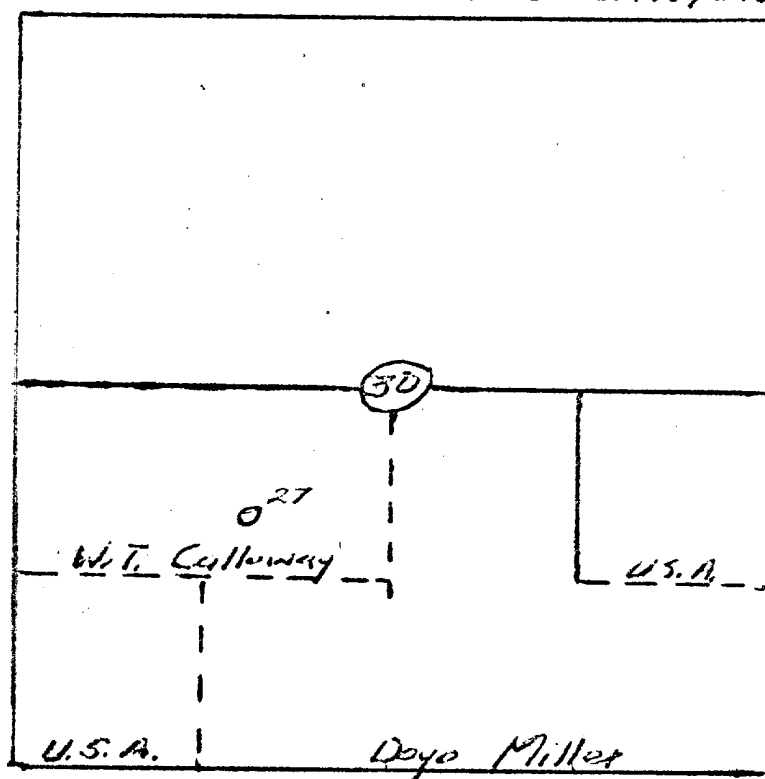


PLAT OF SECTION 30 - Twp 24N - R12W

OF #27 GALLEGOS CANYON UNIT

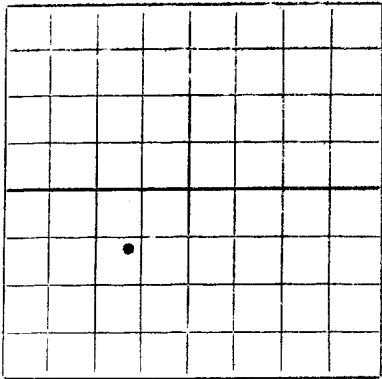

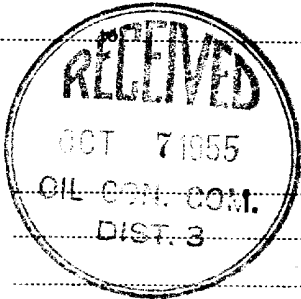
