1. That she is the owner of certain properties upon which Fred Mendenhall whose address is unknown drilled a well to test for hydrocarbons and/or carbon dioxide gas and said well is described as the Bergin #1, being located 100 feet from the North line and 2100 feet from the West line of Section 21, Township 29N, Range 11W, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

2. That said well was drilled prior to 1940 and that the well was not drilled beyond 300 feet of depth.

3. That the present whereabouts of the operator is not known to the landowner and that it is the desire of the landowner to have the above described well transferred to her for conversion to her use as a water well.
