Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of April 4, 1955, regarding your Carroll-Cornell Well No. 5-A, located in Section 13, Township 29 Marth, Range 12 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, in which you inform us of your intention to exchange acreage with the Aztec Oil and Gas Company.

This is to inform you that the communitization which you propose will be satisfactory with this Commission and if the combined acreage resulting therefrom consists of from 158 to 162 acres, this unit will be considered as a standard proration unit by this Commission.

However, I feel I should inform you that this exchange of acreage must take place, and the Commission must be notified of the exchange by May 1, 1955, for the aforementioned well to remain on the proration schedule. If you cannot complete your negotiations with the Aztec Oil and Gas Company by the May 1st. deadline, I would suggest that you make application for a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the acreage presently dedicated to said well in order for your well to remain on the proration schedule.
