County, New Mexico.

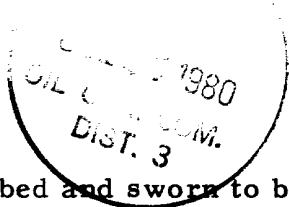
3. That said well was drilled to a total depth of 1170 feet, and that cas-

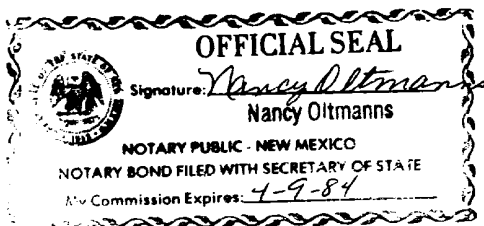


