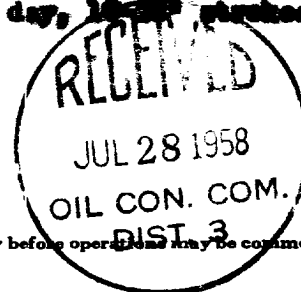
DETAILS OF WORK

Ute Mountain Tribal #1 Well No. 1. Spotted 900 gallons 1% mud acid on bottom. Perforated Verde-Gallup pay with four shots per foot 2441-2700. Sand-oil fracked with 27,900 gallons oil and 30,700 pounds sand. Formation broke at 1700', injection rate 95 barrels per minute. 2" tubing landed at 2674'. Completed as pumping Verde Gallup Field Development Oil Well July 23, 1958.

Potential test July 23, 1958 pumped 60 barrels oil per day, 10-15 strokes per minute.
