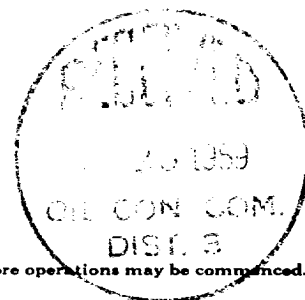

DETAILS OF WORK

Rosa Unit 35-5. Spudded 12-1/4 inch hole on August 13, 1959 and drilled to 326 feet. Reamed 17-1/4 inch hole to 320 feet. 13-3/8 inch Arco casing set at 320 feet with 275 sacks of regular cement. Cement circulated. Circulated out approximately 50 sacks of cement. After waiting on cement, tested casing and water shut off with 250 psi pressure, which held with no indication of pressure drop.
