DETAIL FOR LT SHUT IN EXTENSIONS

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. requests a one year extension of the long term shut-in status for the wells listed in the table attached. The extension is necessary due to the time required to evaluate a waterflood expansion pilot.

A detailed reservoir study of the West Bisti Unit has indicated that a substantial amount of additional oil can be recovered by revamping the waterflood. In order to determine if the additional oil can be recovered economically, a pilot waterflood expansion is expected to be completed in the First Quarter of 1988. The complete analysis of the pilot is expected to take approximately one year. Well No.'s 123, 141 and 134 have been recently shut in due to their uneconomic status. These wells could also be utilized in revamping the waterflood. A one year shut in status is requested for these wells.

Based upon the results of the waterflood expansion, these wells will be 1) utilized in revamping the complete waterflood in 1989 or 2) plugged and abandoned in 1989.
