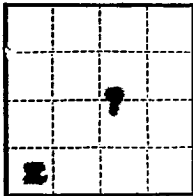

**DETAILS OF WORK**

Rotary drilling equipment will be used to drill to approximately 1400', a 5" casing. Casing Program 200' of 5-1/2" cemented to surface. Required amount of 1/2" production casing will be run and cemented with sufficient volume of cement to cover the highest potentially productive zone. This program will consist of making sure from surface to 1400', and a low section will be 5 to 7' on base to total depth. Electric logs, etc. will be run prior to setting production casing or abandonment of well. Stimulation treatments such as acidizing or fracturing may be employed in completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

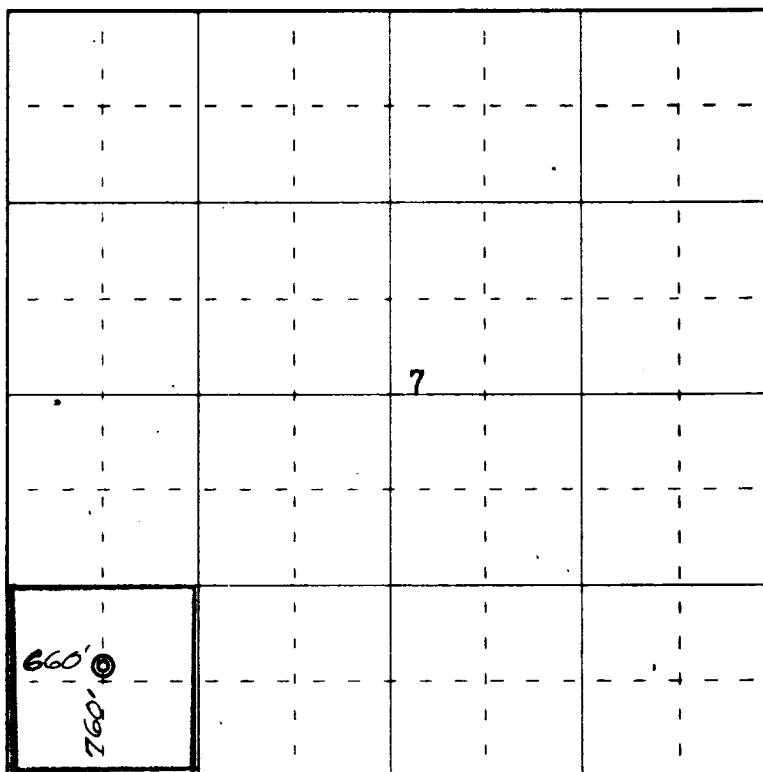
