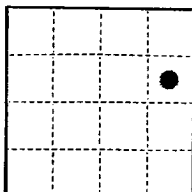

30,000 gallons oil and 25,000 lbs. sand. Run 2" tubing, install rods and  
pump.

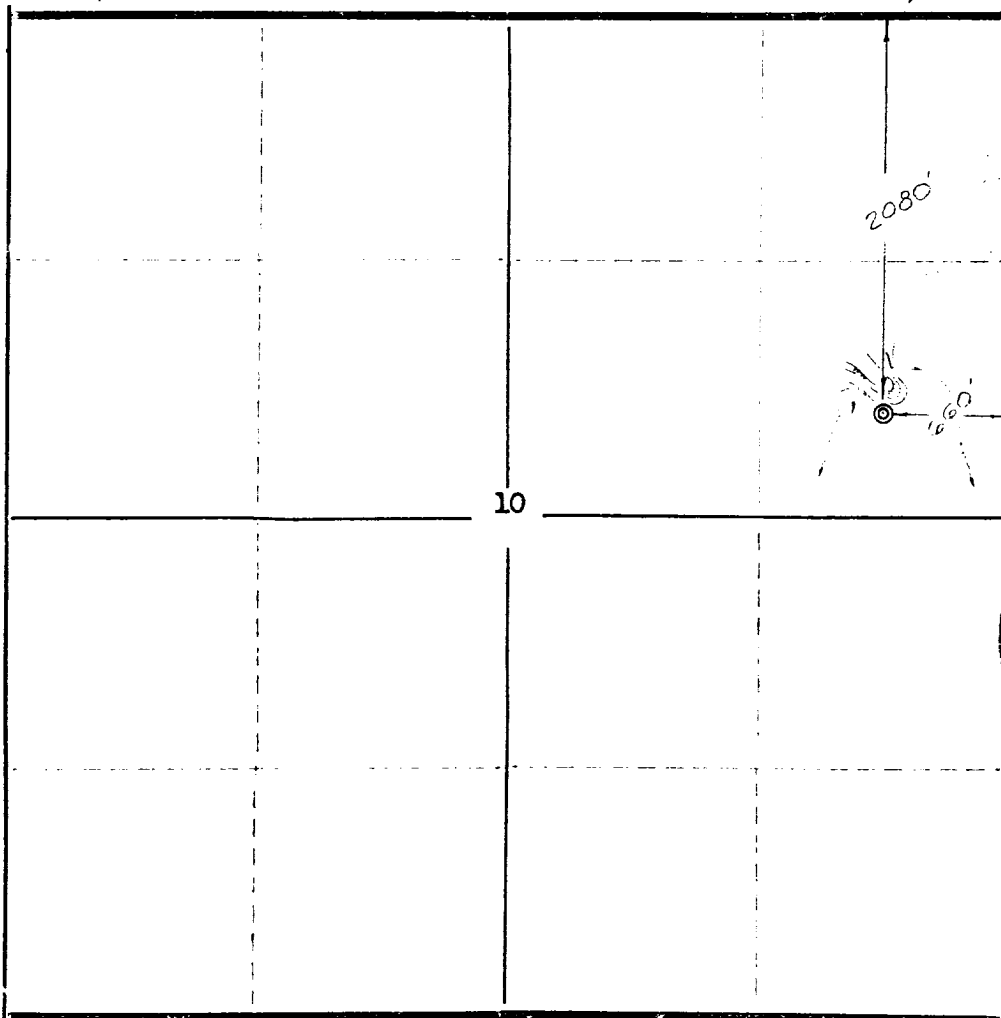
