Dear Mr. Johnson,

Allstate Environmental Services has been contracted by Yates Petroleum to conduct cleanup/remediation work at the subject tank battery. On October 17, 2005, Yates experienced a spill of 42 bbls. of oil and 75 bbls. of produced water. 40 bbls. of oil and 70 bbls. of water were recovered by vacuum truck. The attached drawing with a sample table indicates no TPH impact and some chlorides impact in the Sxp-2 area.

On behalf of Yates, Allstate proposes to excavate the 50 ft. x 50 ft. impacted area inside the berm area to a level of 8 ft. in the Sxp-2 area and taper up to 4' to the Sxp-1 area. A one ft. clay liner would then be emplaced and compacted to prevent leaching and covered by the excavated soil. Ranking criteria for this site is "0".

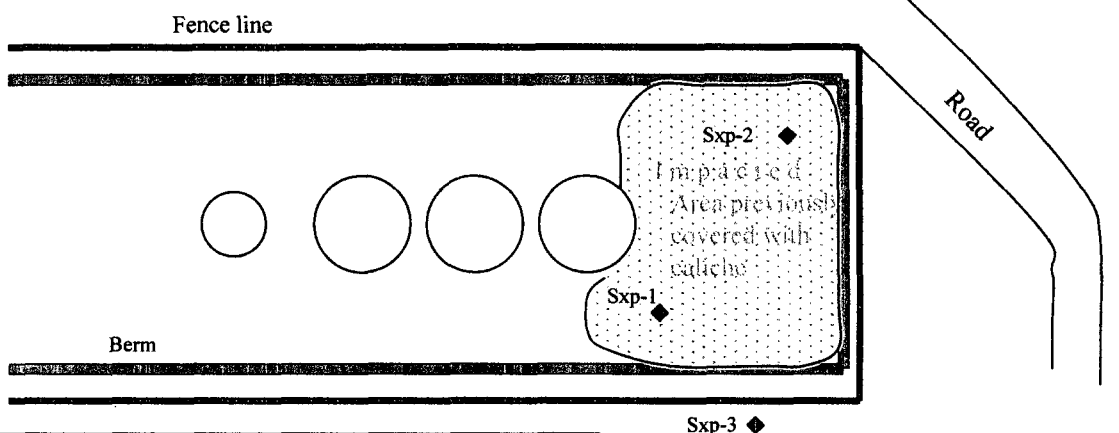
