The data in the submitted report for 1RP-4870 indicates that delineation is not completed. Please review the directive appended to the reviewed initial C-141. In summary, please be advised that

- 1. NMOCD does not accept composite samples.
- 2. There is an identified NMOSE water well within 1000 ft. (L10304), which lowers the RRALs.
- 3. For complete release characterization/delineation, each sample location must demonstrate at least 2 depths of permissible contaminant levels (BTEX, TPH, and chlorides): depth obtained and depth maintained at least 2-3 ft. further in depth. Horizontally, establish sample locations at the lateral extent of release, including misted area. Representative sample locations should be no greater than 50 ft. apart.
- 4. Sample location IDs must be used consistently in text, figures, maps, and laboratory reports.
- 5. Provide data in a tabulated format along with GPS coordinates for the sample locations. All laboratory data should have accompanying field data.
- 6. Remedial activities may be proposed, but will not be considered until delineation is considered complete and approved by NMOCD.
