The spills are in the process of being delineated concurrently, using the methodology described in the "Proposed Activities" section of the 12/4/2017 "Delineation Plan" for the 1RP-4855 release (as well as the 12/29/2017 email response from Ms. Yu).

Upon receipt of laboratory analytical results from the delineation event, an "Environmental Site Summary & Remediation Proposal" (Work Plan) will be developed, outlining an appropriate soil remediation strategy for the site. The Work Plan will be submitted to both the NMOCD and NMSLO for review and approval prior to conducting any excavation activities. The releases will be remediated concurrently.
