#### Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

On 04/02/2017, Frontier received a call from a pumper in the area about a possible leak located in the PLSS. Frontier dispatched field personnel to identify the leak. When the pipeline was identified as Rhombus Union St Com I, the pipeline was immediately blocked in. Notifications were made internally to the Environmental Group on 4/3/2017. On 04/04/2017 Frontier estimated the release at ~ 10 – 15 bbl and made immediate notifications to NMOCD. Excavation was commenced immediately to delineate and remove contaminated soils and to restore the integrity of the pipeline. All contaminated soils have been removed and analytical soil samples show remaining soil to be below applicable NMOCD cleanup levels.

#### Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Excavation of impacted soils continued until TPH, BTEX, and Benzene levels were below levels outlined in the "NMOCD Guidelines for Remediation of Leaks, Spills, and Releases." Impacted soil was transported to an NMOCD approved facility for disposal, and the area was backfilled with clean soil. Impacted soils were placed on a 20-mil liner during excavation. All supporting documentation, including remediation and closure reports as well as analytical laboratory reports have been provided to the NMOCD and the State Land Office. Email confirmation of closure was granted by NMOCD and SLO on 3/9/18.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment.
