Ms. Gonzales:

NMOCD approves of the delineation completed for 1RP-4812 and proposed remediation with the following conditions:

1. Chloride analyses of confirmation bottom and sidewall samples at no greater than 75 ft. apart. At least one sample location must be at the border between the area represented by BH1 & BH2/3 and 1 between BH2/3 & BH 5/6.
2. Demarcate confirmation sample locations on an appropriately scaled map (or tabulate) with GPS coordinates.
3. Follow-up and inform NMOCD and NMSLO on the impacted area in the vicinity of the EOG right-of-way. Closure/deferral will not be granted until this part of the release is addressed.
4. Photo documentation of remedial activities/area to be deferred within the right-of-way.

Like approval from NMSLO required. NMSLO may have additional stipulations.
