Dear Mr. Roberson:

A NMOCD inspector was on location and observed a major release this morning around 11 am MST, April 24, 2018, coming from a transfer pump and discharge line for the battery on the well pad of API 30-025-24836. This release appears to be ongoing for some time, based on the site evaluation and impacted area, estimated at greater than 200 yards in length, with standing pools of fluids.

Per NMAC 19.15.29, NMOCD requires verbal notification within 24 hours of discovery of a major release (>25 bbls of liquids, condensate, combination). Please submit a form C-141 to NMOCD and BLM within 15 days.

be advised that NMOCD does not preclude the Responsible Operator from any immediate clean-up of impacted areas, such as vacuuming of standing fluids, removal of heavily impacted surfaces).
