The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) of New Mexico is in receipt of the 2017 Annual Groundwater Monitoring Report for the 14 inch Vac to Jal Legacy 1R-2162. The report details data and requests.

The following:

1. OCD approves the weekly PSH recovery on monitor well MW-1.
2. OCD approves the sampling of wells MW's 2 through 14 for BTEX, chloride and PAH (extended range) on quarterly basis. OCD anticipates that the top of casing on the newer wells (MW's 10-14) to be surveyed in for additional assessment of gradient in groundwater. This should help delineate the horizontal extent of contamination plume(s).
3. OCD approves the use of the MDPE process and scheduling of events to maximize recovery efforts.
4. OCD approves the timing for scheduled groundwater sampling, protocols for sampling and Methodologies for sample analysis.
5. If anything highly unusual occurs during placement/sampling of newer wells please discuss with OCD before scheduled 2018 Annual Report.
