Mr. Arguijo:

NMOCD approves of the delineation completed and proposed remediation for 1RP-4888 with these clarifications:

- Both bottom and sidewall confirmation samples are required for each of the proposed depths of excavation at no greater than 50 ft. intervals.
- At least one confirmation sidewall/edge sample location must be at the border

- between each different depth of excavation.
- Marked confirmation sample locations in relation to delineation sample locations on a scaled map.
- Dated photo documentation of the remediation process.
