Hi Olivia,

An update on 1RP-4715. Regarding our activities at Salado Draw 1RP-4715, we have completed the soil work on the north side of the road above the high pressure gas line. Lab results from every 50yds showed all values were below <600 mg/kg with the highest single value being 360 mg/kg. The soil has been replaced and will be seeded with BLM seed mix next week.

Regarding the south side, we excavated soil 100' by 8'. Composite samples for soil from the south range from 7 mg/kg to 260 mg/kg (see Larson Environmental notes below). We called you to discuss replacement of this soil vs disposal but you were not available. In you absence we contacted Shelly Tucker with the BLM and reviewed the analytical with her and she recommended we place this blended soil back in the excavated site. We are following through with her recommendation. We will also be seeding this area next week. We will send final remediation report with analytical and photos within two weeks.

The laboratory reported chloride at 260 mg/Kg and 7.56 mg/Kg in composite soil samples Comp 8 and Comp 9 from the excavated soil from S-7 (south side of lease road). The chloride concentration in the bottom samples from the excavation range from discrete <1.14 mg/Kg (Bottom East) to 25.1 mg/Kg (Bottom West). The chloride concentration in the excavation sidewall samples ranges from <1.08 mg/Kg (South Side) to 19.2 mg/Kg (East Side). The excavation on the north side of the lease road (main spill area) has been backfilled with the excavated soil. Please contact me to discuss and how you would like to proceed. Sweatt released the dump trucks this afternoon but will return in the morning.
