Good Morning,

This email is a follow up to the phone conversation on September 5, regarding remediation activities at the Plains Pipeline COG Becknell State COM 3H Release Site (1RP-5109). The site is located in Unit Letter K, Sec. 5, T21S, R33E of Lea County New Mexico. The crude oil release was attributed to packing failure on the Tri-Plex pump which resulted in a release of approximately 6.8 barrels of

crude oil with approximately 4 barrels recovered. Due to safety concerns associated with various structures including but not limited to lacts, pumps, electrical lines, tanks and pipelines, Plains is requesting NMOCD and NMSLO approval to backfill the excavated area with non-impacted, locally obtained soil. The pump skid will be temporarily relocated (with COG approval) and the release will be vertically delineated. Attached are the Site Location Map (Figure 1), Soil Sample Location Map (Figure 2) and Soil Chemistry Table for your convenience.

With NMOCD and NMSLO approval, Plains will commence with the described activities. On completion of the described activities, a Work Plan will be submitted to the NMOCD and NMSLO.
