- Dated, geo-referenced photo documentation for verification that the initial response activities have been employed to contain the release is requested.
- For future releases, please be advised that per 19.15.29.7 NMAC, a fire is considered a major release; therefore, notification to NMOCD Environmental Bureau Chief is required.
