Please be advised that

1. The initial portion of the C-141 form does not include calculations to determine the release volume. When was the tank battery gauged and difference in depth of fluids observed?
2. Per 19.15.29.13 NMAC, regulations of corresponding agencies supersede NMOCD's.
3. Dated, geo-referenced photo documentation for verification that the initial response activities have been employed to contain the release is requested.

Good morning,

Marathon Oil is currently investigating a tank leak at the State AA No. 1 occurring on 10/18/18. The Site Operator reported staining around one of the produced water tanks. Approximately 232 barrels of produced water was released, confirmed by the tank gauges. The previous tank gauge was 7'7" and the tank gauge was reported at 10". It is believed the release was due to a hole that developed on the bottom of the tank. Souder Miller and Associates will be onsite early next week. The tank has been taken out of service and there are no recoverable liquids.

A C141 will be submitted shortly.
