Please see the attached corrective action plan for the Battle 34 Federal 4H well pad where 23 bbls of produced water was spilled. I am having them resample point 6; it is more than likely a typo since all other sample points are not in that range. Please keep in mind that this was

on the well pad only and the depth to groundwater is greater than 250'.

I have the crew scheduled for the week after Thanksgiving since many of them will not be available until next year due to the holidays. It is my goal to have this closed before the new year.
