Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Phillips Petroleum Company Max Well No. One in the NE/4 of NE/4 of Sec. 30, T. 20-S, R. 37-E, N. M. P. M., Monument Field, Lee County.

The dates of this work were as follows: May 10, 1937.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 3843 in lime. Treated pay formations from 3754 to 3843 with 7000 gallons Dowell "XI" instead of 8000 gallons as originally planned.

Started swabbing immediately. Recovered 124 barrels oil load & acid in 13 hours. Next day swabbed 18 hours recovering 101 barrels oil load & acid water. Following day swabbed 64 barrels fresh oil in 13 hours. Pulled tubing. Bailed out water used to wash out fibertex & aquagel. Started flowing. Flowed 61 bbl fresh oil & water load in 14 hrs through casing. Flowed 42 barrels in 19 hours while running tubing & 84 bbl. fresh oil and water in 5 hours through tubing by heads. Following day flowed 24 hours natural through 2 1/2" tubing by heads. 139 barrels oil. Cutting 3% BS and water.
