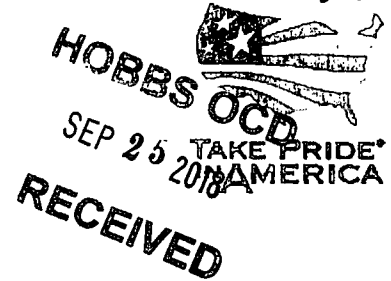

Please note on the resubmitted APD that they were previously approved and we will review the expired file for information which will help expedite the processing.
