### Gathering System and Pipeline Notification

The wells will be connected to production facilities after flowback operations are complete so long as the gas transporter system is in place. The gas produced from the production facilities should be connected to an Energy Transfer Partners gathering system. It will require ~750' of pipeline to connect each facility to the Energy Transfer Partners gathering system. Matador Production Company periodically provides a drilling, completion and estimated first production date for wells that are scheduled to be drilled in the foreseeable future to Energy Transfer Partners.
