DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8964' Total Depth. Line. Finished drilling 7-7/8" hole @ 11:45 AM on 8/4/53. Ran Schlumberger surveys. To plug and abandon well filled hole with heavy drilling mud and spotted a 35 sack cement plug from 8700' to 8576'; a 35 sack cement plug from 3625' to 3513'. Ran Bia-Log casing cutters and shot casing off @ 455' and salvaged 455' of 8-5/8" OD casing. Ran cement plug of 10 sacks from 296' to 282' and spotted a 10 sack cement plug in top of 13-3/8" OD casing. Cemented a piece of 4" line pipe in top of 13-3/8" OD casing which extends five feet above ground level and serves as a marker. Well plugged and abandoned on August 6, 1953.
