This is to advise that subject well was deepened to 13, 685' in the Devonian from the previous TD of 13,225'. The well was acidized with 2500 gallons of acid and 13,100 feet of $3-\frac{1}{2}$ -inch plastic-line tubing installed on a tubing hangar set at approximately 10,000' below the surface.

The well was tested at 15,000 BPD injectivity on a vacuum and put in service for disposal in mid-September, 1968.
