

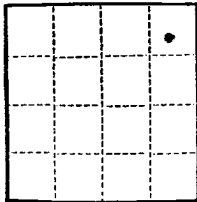

Will drill to San Andres pay horizon, total depth approximately 5050 feet, with rotary tools. Set approximately 375 feet of 8-5/8", 28# surface casing, circulating cement to surface. Set 4-1/2", 11.60# casing to total depth. Cement production casing with approximately 350 sacks cement. Run Gammaray Nuetron logs and perforate casing. Treat with approximately 10,000 gallons of Acid.

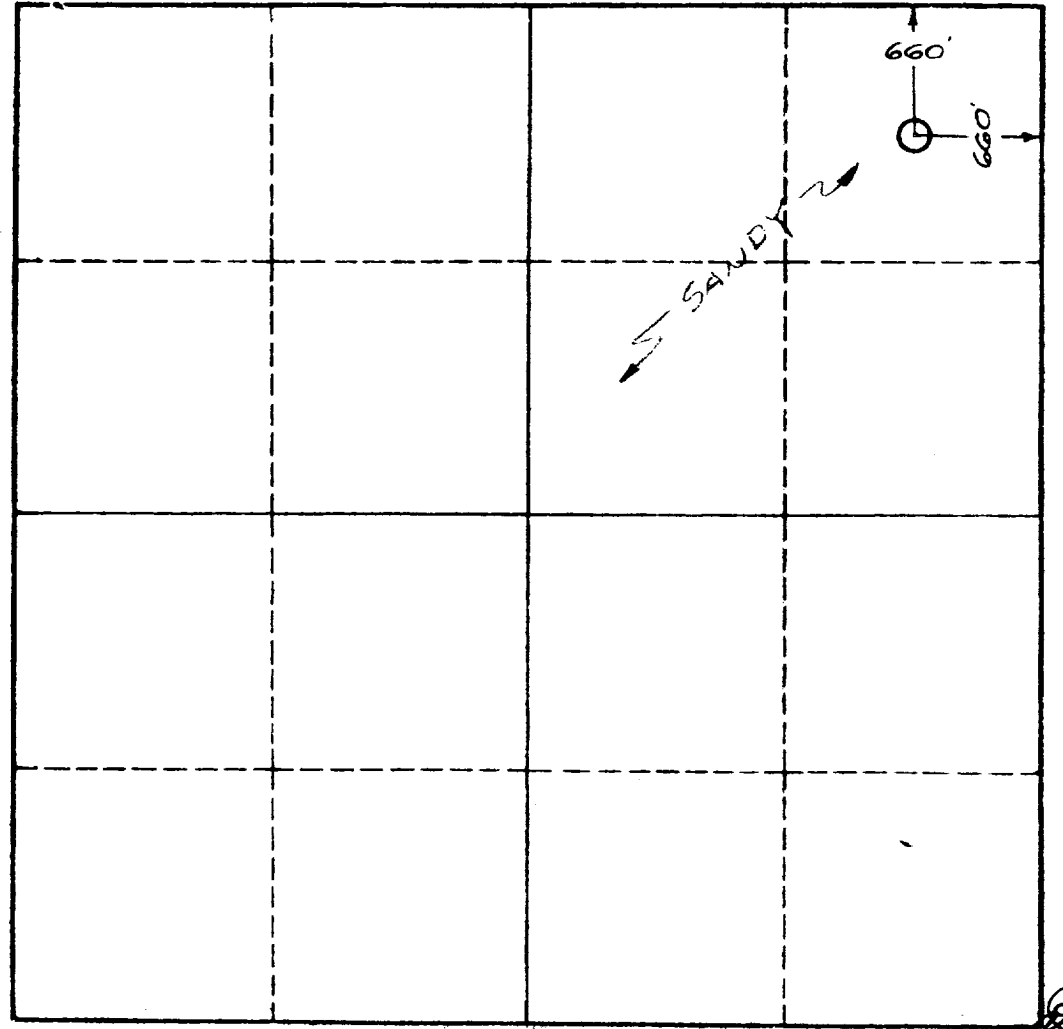
