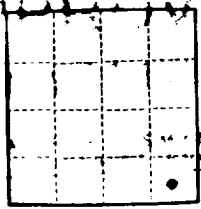

DETAILS OF WORK

Set names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)
Set 4 1/2", 9.5# CSG @ 3059' with 200 sacks of 50/50 Pozmix plus 35 gallons of Lotus cement. Puff: 4925-4951.5 and 4966-4999 with 4 jet shots per foot. Set packer @ 4861'. Acidized with 500 gallons mud acid, scrubbed back acid water. Re-set packer @ 4767' and acidized with 10,000 gallons regular acid with 100 lbs. moth balls, after 5,000'. Flowed back acid water and started making oil and gas - now testing.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
