Gentlemen:

Due to the recently submitted "scheduled" gas/oil ratio test the above-referenced well will be reclassified to gas effective March 1, 1989, or when the requirements of R-5353 have been met.

In order to meet the requirements as outlined in R-5353 for a gas well in the Bluitt San Andres Associated Pool, please submit a C-102, acreage dedication plat, dedicating 320 acres to this gas well or obtain approval of a non-standard gas proration unit.

A 40-acre non-standard proration unit (NSP-1439) was obtained when this well was originally completed as an oil well but it will need to be amended to cover a gas well. Your production is marginal and does not look as if your production would be curtailed by the acreage factor. You might point this out in your letter of application to our Santa Fe office.

Please send a copy of your NSP application to this office.
